Terms and Conditions

The Siegfried Petersen Educational Trust Committee shall annually grant a minimum of three scholarships as follows:

- A. To at least two needy recipients of good moral character who reside in the Bennett Community School District as it was defined in August, 1994.
- B. To at least one needy recipient of good moral character who is a resident of Cedar County.

The recipient shall be a person who shows a desire to improve his or her station in life through education and would return those benefits to the community. It is not necessary that the recipient be a top scholar or athlete. He or she should be a good citizen who expresses a desire to lead a life of service to our community and our country.

The recipient may pursue any course of studies, undergraduate or graduate level, at any educational organization, which normally maintains a regular faculty and curriculum (colleges, universities, nursing schools, technical schools, etc.) public or private. The recipient must be enrolled in a minimum of a one-year program.

Recipients and non-recipients are welcome to reapply each year. Finalists may be required to have an interview with the committee.

The school of the recipient's choice will receive payment of one-half the scholarship amount at the start of the fall semester of enrollment. If the student remains in good standing, the second one-half of the scholarship will be paid to the school at the start of the second semester.

Application must be **received** in the **Bennett School District Office** by noon on March 24, 2023. Please postmark by March 18th to insure delivery.

Recipients of the scholarship will receive notification of their selection by May 15, 2023.

Siegfried Petersen Scholarship Narratives

Please supply your response to each of the following. Answers should be **typed** and limited to **one page** for each question.

1) Siegfried Petersen, the contributor of this scholarship, immigrated to the United States from northern Germany in 1927 at age 18. He was the youngest of nine children and with his father and one brother already casualties of World War I he felt his future in Germany was dismal. Siegfried's father's second cousin, Edward Lorenzen of Olin sponsored his trip to the United States at a cost of \$196.20 and had \$25 waiting for Siegfried when he arrived in New York. When Mr. Petersen arrived in Olin he immediately repaid his cousin the \$25 and had \$2.56 left in his pocket, enough to buy a pair of work shoes and have a little change left. Mr. Petersen never married nor had any children. He worked in Cedar County for many farmers and enlisted in 1942 and served this country in Africa and Italy during World War II. When he returned to Bennett after the war he rented a farm and in 1956 bought 160 acres for \$365 an acre. Mr. Petersen left his estate to many charitable organizations in Cedar County including this endowment for a scholarship.
